Students will have to make an online payment of Rs. 100/- towards online Application form. Students should note that their login ID (e-mail ID) and Password is remains same of previous year.


Course Fees payment are to be made through online only and that too with full payment through Debit Card, Credit Card or Net Banking

Eligibility for Second Year Program:

Student have passed in both SEM-I and SEM-II of F.Y.

OR

Student have fails in not more than two subjects in each of semester I & semester II of First Year (A student shall be Allowed To Keep Term (ATKT) in Second Year and Student is require to pass the Failed subjects).

Eligibility for Third Year Program:

Student have passed in both SEM-I and SEM-II of First Year Program & both SEM-III and SEM-IV of Second Year Program.

OR

Student have fails in not more than two subjects in each of semester I and semester II of First Year and student must have passed Second Year semester III and semester IV in full. (A student shall be allowed To Keep Term (ATKT) in Third Year and Student is require to pass the Failed subjects of First Year).

OR

Student have fails in not more than two subjects in each semester III and semester IV of Second Year and student must have passed First Year semester I and semester II in full. (A student shall be allowed To Keep Term (ATKT) in Third Year and Student is require to pass the Failed subjects of Second Year).

In case of any query /confusion, student can contact respective program coordinator.

Note: Students are required to check the eligibility before filling of admission form and payment of fee.
